


OUR MISSION

Transition school to employment

- Youth Coaching
- Services to find out skills and competences of young people
- Vocational trainings for PwD or youth not able to find work after school
- Adapted apprenticeship
 - Extended time
 - Parts are picked and certified
- Assistance in finding a job
- Assistance in keeping a job



Services

- Coaching
- Trainings to find out skills and competences and develop vocational perspectives
- Short trainings to be ready to join the open labour market
- Longer vocational trainings for the target group to learnon the labour market needed skills
- Supported Employment
- Production schools for young people
